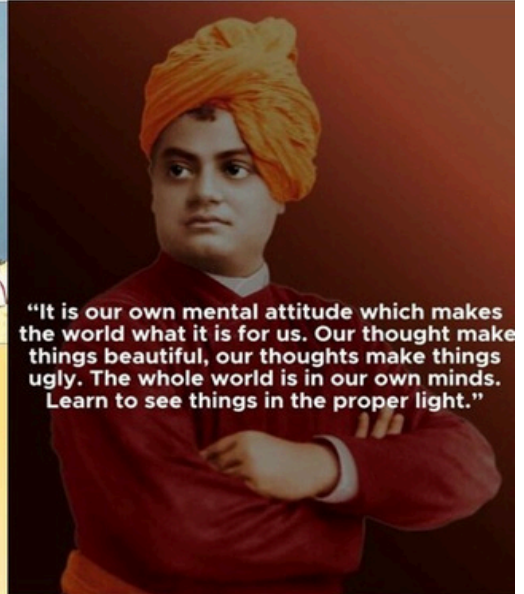

UNIVERSAL TEACHINGS OF SWAMI VIVEKANANDA on EDUCATION

Swami Vivekananda believed education is the manifestation of perfection already in men. To Swami Vivekananda, education was not only collection of information, but something more meaningful. He felt

- Education should be man-making, life giving and character-building.
- Education was an assimilation of noble ideas.
- Education must have life building, man making, character making assimilation of ideas.

According to Swami Vivekananda, education is incomplete without the teaching of aesthetics or fine arts. The knowledge of values and not of facts was his aim of education. Education is not the amount of information that we put into your brain and runs riot there, undigested, all your life.

Swami Vivekananda wanted to re-introduce value-based education and imbibe human values in people. He said that education should cover all parts of life like physical, intellectual, material, emotional, moral, and spiritual. His teachings were based on Ramakrishna's spiritual teachings of the Divine manifestations.

If you have assimilated five ideas and made them your life and character, you have more education than any man who has got by heart a whole library.

Swami Vivekananda felt that the education that young boys and girls receive is very negative. He thinks they do not gain confidence or self-respect from this education, so according to Swami Vivekananda only positive education should be given to children. He also told the youth:

Set yourselves to the task of spreading education among the masses. Tell them and make them understand, "You are our brothers—a part and parcel of our bodies, and we love you and never hate you.

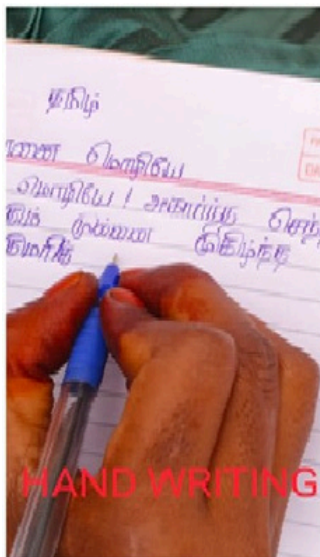


Independence day Celebration on 15th Aug'24 at Bommachikulam

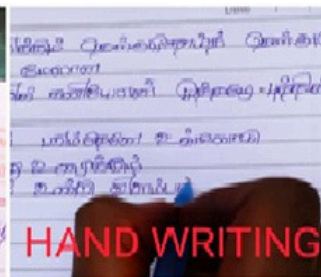

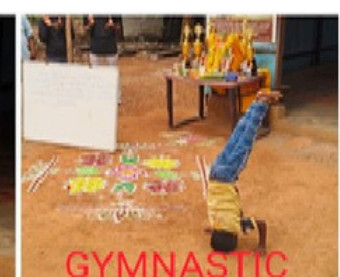

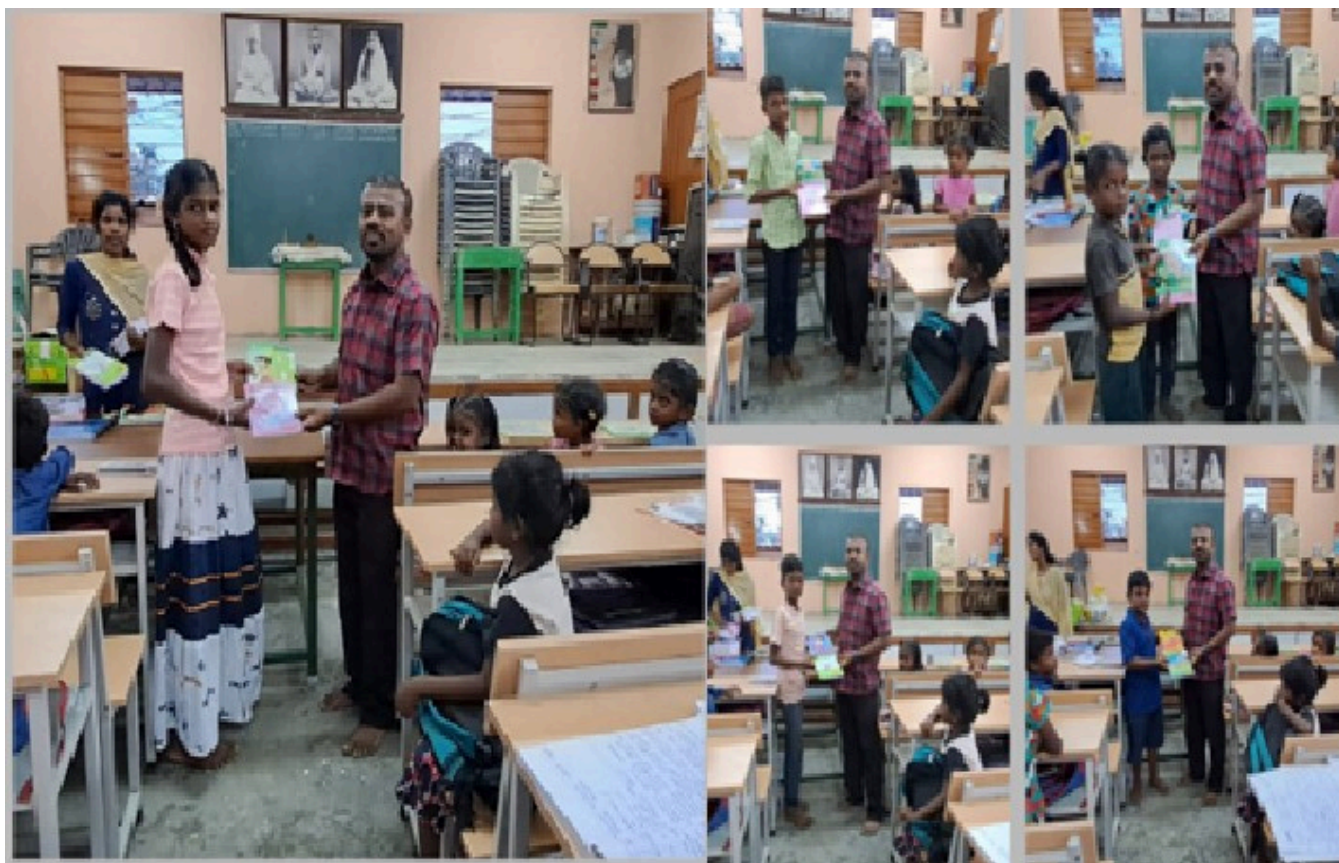

He is currently running an OLDAGE HOME in Madipakkam under the banner AALAVRIKSHAM from the Year 2022 onwards. Started with 2 Senior citizen slowly grown up and currently with 10 inmates. The AALAVRIKSHAM Supporting Senior citizens mainly the abandoned elderly persons & orphaned elders and accommodated them in a rented care home.



Sri. Raja mentined that this kind of thought came up to him by the grace of Gurumaharaj blessings. He still remember how he has been brought up by RKMSH. 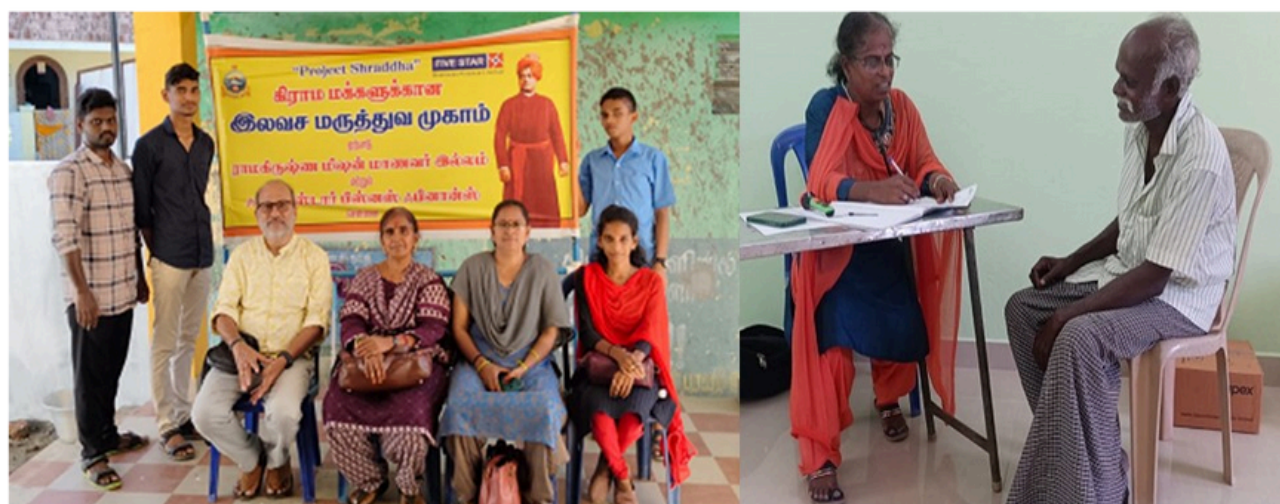

He started Sri Ramakrishna Math Chennai, Sri Ramakrishna Math Bangalore, Ramakrishna Mission Students Home in Mylapore, National School for Girls, George Town, Chennai & Publication of books on Ramakrishna – Vivekananda from Madras.

Extensive travels he undertook to all southern states and as a result of his visits, many centres of Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission came up in some of the places later. His writings and lectures include Life of Sri Ramanuja, God and Divine Incarnation, The Message of Eternal Wisdom, Sri Krishna: Pastoral and the King Maker, For Thinkers on Education, The Ancient Quest, Consolations, The Soul of Man, The Universe and Man, Path to Perfection, Sri Ramkkrishna and His Mission.

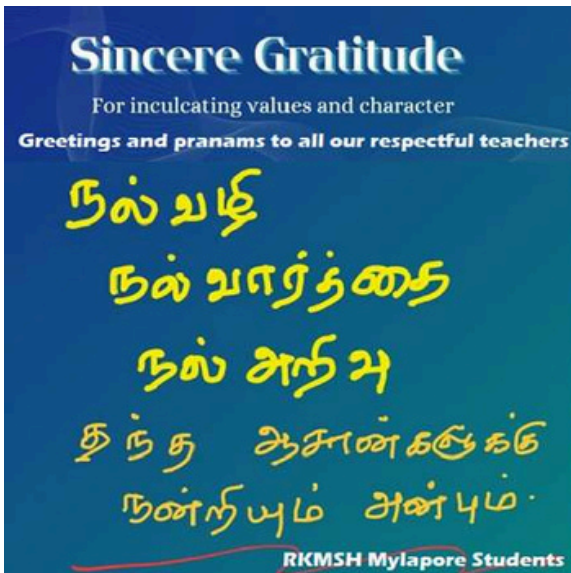

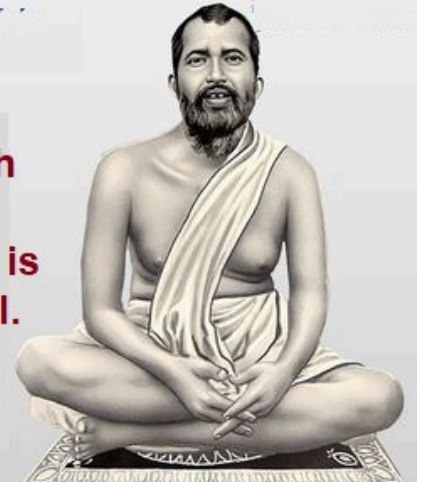

he Ramakrishna Mission spent Rs 1,292 crore on social welfare, education, and rural development in 2023-24. The 115th annual general meeting of RKM was held at the Belur Math recently. Swami Gautamanandaji, president of Ramakrishna Math and Mission, chaired the meeting. The report of the governing body of Ramakrishna Mission for 2023-24 was presented by Swami Suvirananda, general secretary of Ramakrishna Math and Mission. RKM spent Rs 712.89 crore on the education of students across the country.

In Jhargram, it has taken over an Ekalavya Residential School meant for ST students. The students have secured excellent results in various examinations. Most of the students are first-generation learners. It has spent Rs 26.50 crore on Ramakrishna Vivekananda Vedanta literature. It is to be noted that the interest in reading the Ramakrishna Vivekananda Vedanta literature is growing among the youths.

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The RKM is organizing youth conferences across the country to propagate the man-making character-building education of Swami Vivekananda. RKM spent Rs 496.70 crore to provide medical assistance to 79.28 lakh people. It has a hospital, a postgraduate institute, and a nursing institute at the Ramakrishna Mission Seva Pratisthan. Two full-fledged hospitals in Lucknow and Vrindavan, run by the RKM, are catering to lakhs of people.

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The Ramakrishna Math and Mission, through their one hundred centers situated in 24 countries outside India, carried out various service activities. The school at Viveknagar in Tripura was declared an exemplary CBSE school by the chairperson of CBSE. In 2023-24, six branch centers of RKM started in Gurugram, Kalyani, Kharupetia, Sakwar, Thirumukkudal, and Ujjain.
